The aim of the Jamboree is to get woodturners to do what they do best, (talk) swap ideas, demonstrate or just do your own thing but mainly to have some fun.

Bring a lathe, chucks, tools and wood for a weekend of turning or just yourself and enjoy the camaraderie with other woodturners. Trade Stalls will be available where you can purchase tools and wood.

Woodturning Competition Rules

(Open to registered participants only)

We will be having two categories, Woodturning Open Artistic and Woodturning Traditional.

Prizes sponsored by the Lake Taupo Wood Workers Guild, National Association of Woodworkers Inc, Turning Tools Ltd and Treeworkx.

Open Artistic: more than 10% texturing or carving but must have had some lathe work.

Traditional: must have no texturing or carving. This category is for those who like the more traditional work.

There will be only one prize for each category.

All work must have been made by the Woodturner/Artist in the last 12 months and not have won a prize in a competition (excluding club comps.)

No copies will be judged so please put in original works.

We will be having a new judge this year.
